

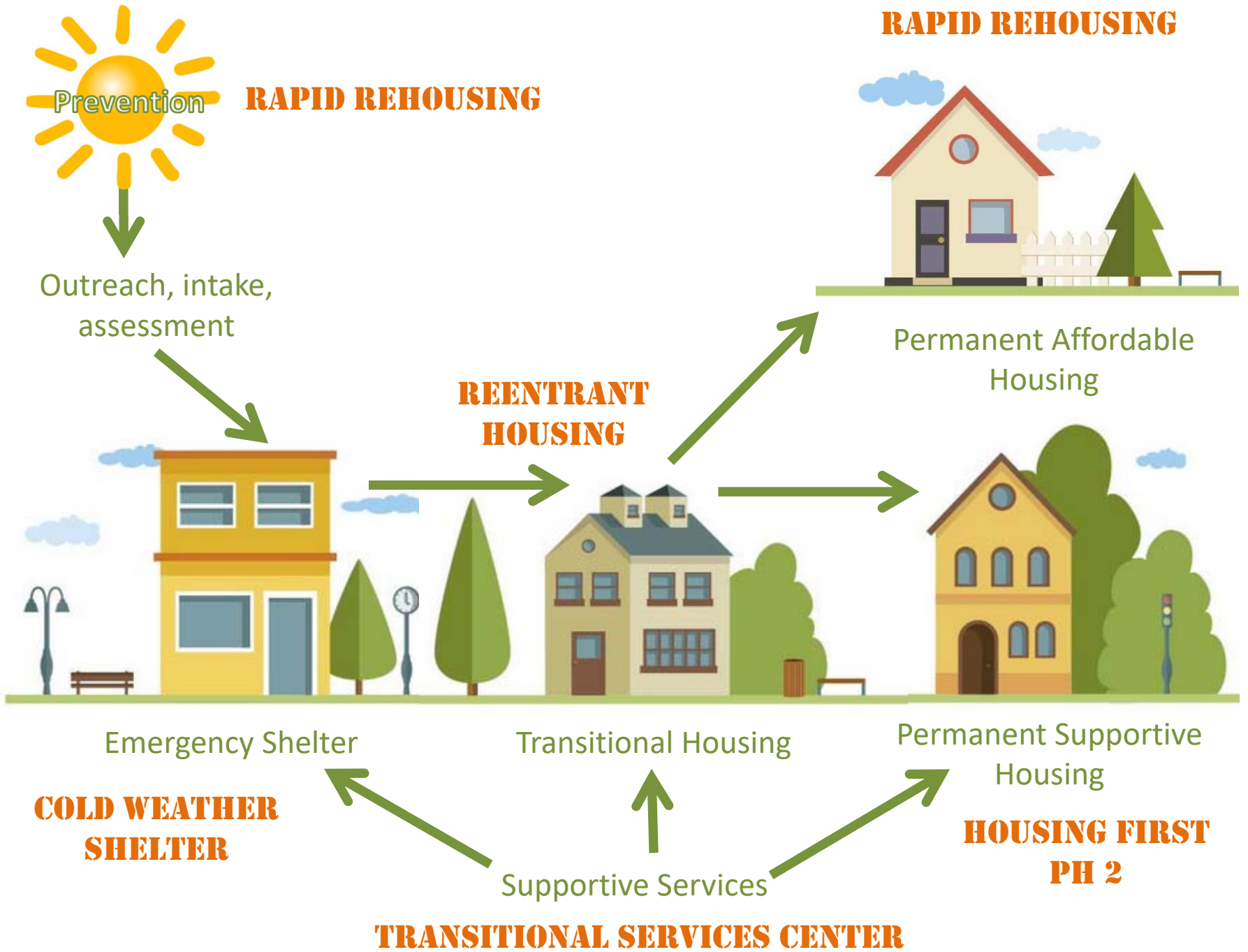

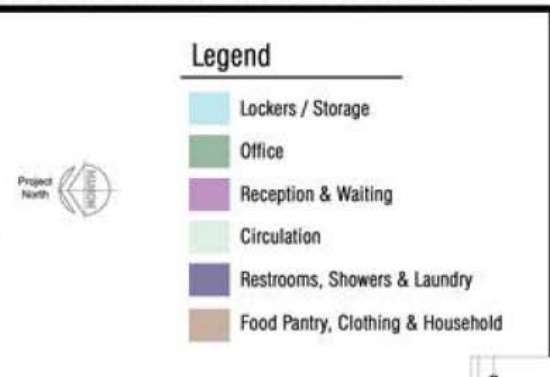

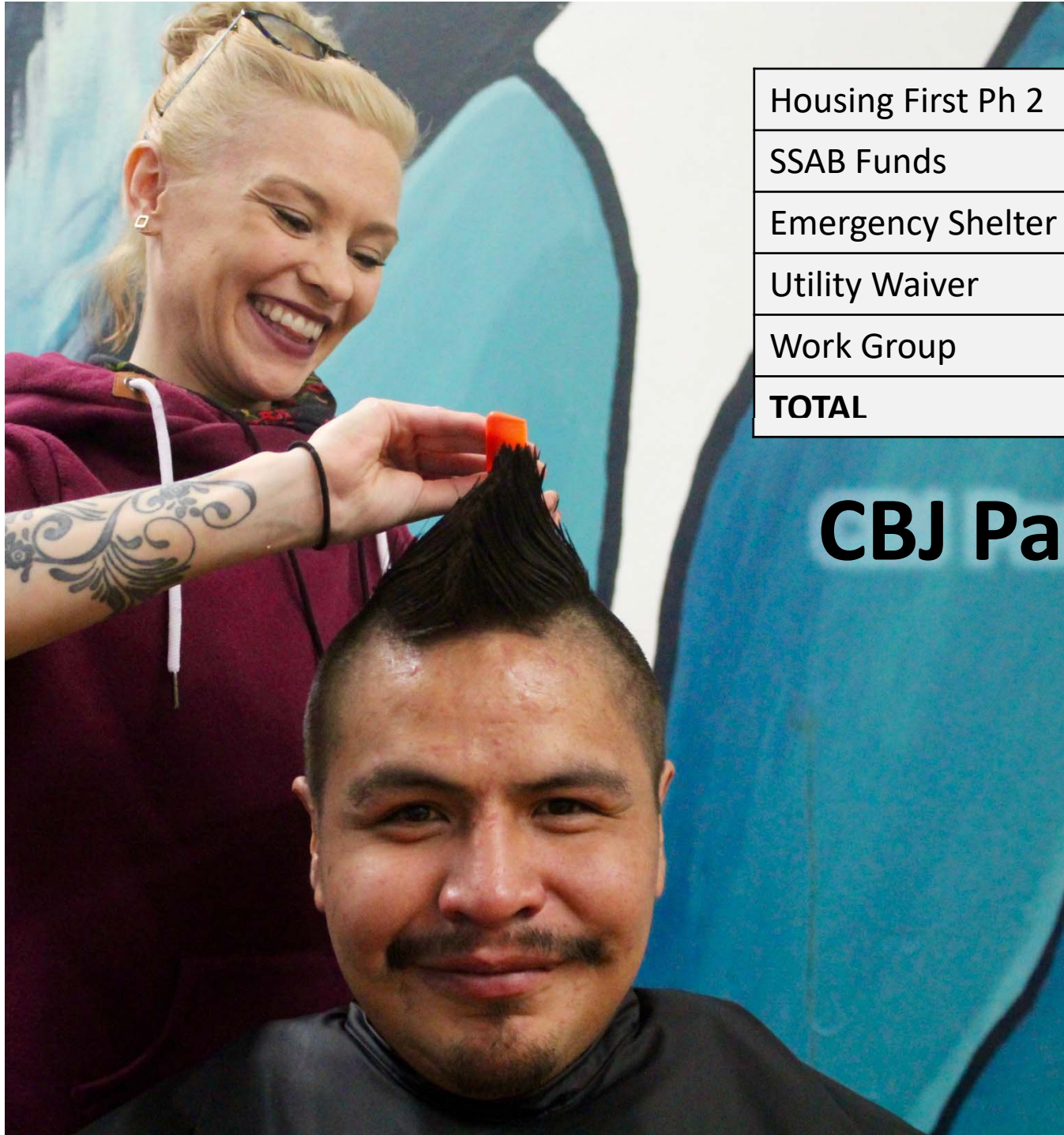
Reentrant Housing: Central Council of Tlingit & Haida Tribes of Alaska

- 16 sober-living beds in eight units
- Full-time on-site manager
- Department of Corrections approval required
- All residents on Electronic Monitoring
- Sex offenders not accepted
- Employment opportunities through Sacred Grounds
- Mandatory Community Service

Goal #1: Assure adequate and affordable housing for all CBJ residents.

- Restructure of Juneau Affordable Housing Fund - \$2 million for 5 years
- Accessory Apartment Incentive - \$480,000 for 5 years
- Mobile Home Down Payment - \$100,000 revolving loan fund
